The issuing *dojo* ("School") of which you have joined is an authorized branch of the International Shinkendo Federation, Aikibujutsu Tanren Kenkyukai, and/or the Kokusai Toyama Ryu Renmei ("ISF/AB/KTRR"), and teaches courses in martial arts using a combination of principles, methods, philosophies, terms, pre-arranged patterns and techniques which are proprietary to the ISF/AB/KTRR and are incorporated in the School's curriculum (collectively, the "Proprietary Curriculum").

You further agree that the Proprietary Curriculum shall remain the property of the ISF/AB/KTRR and that you will not use the Proprietary Curriculum in a manner that is detrimental to or will adversely affect or compete with the ISF/AB/KTRR and/or School.

You agree that if any such obligation is breached, the ISF/AB/KTRR would be irrevocably harmed and that a remedy at law may be inadequate. Therefore, without limiting any other remedy available at law or equity, an injunction, specific performance or other forms of equitable relief or money damages or any combination thereof shall be available to the ISF/AB/KTRR.

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of California, and you consent to personal jurisdiction, service and venue in any Federal or State Court within the State of California having subject matter jurisdiction for the purpose of any action, suit or proceeding arising out of or relating to this Agreement.
